PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING OF PRINCIPALS OF COLLEGES (Excluding B.Ed., Colleges) AFFILIATED TO BENGALURU NORTH UNIVERSITY HELD ON 30™ APRIL 2018 AT 11.00 AM IN THE SEMINAR HALL OF JNANA JYOTHI AUDITORIUM. CENTRAL COLLEGE CAMPUS BENGALURU-560001

The Vice Chancellor, Bengaluru North University welcomed all the Principals of the colleges and explained the purpose/agenda for the meeting. The following agenda was discussed and resolved as follows.

1. Finalisation of UG-Calendar of events for the Academic year 2018-19:

The Vice Chancellor explained the details of draft calendar of events and fee structure for the academic year 2018-19. He has explained that, the calendar of events and the fee structure for UG programmes of BNU is as per Bangalore University calendar of events and fee structure. Bengaluru North University would follow the Bangalore University pattern in both the calendar of events and the Fee structure.

Decision: After detailed discussion, it has been agreed to adopt the calendar events, fee structure, syllabus, eligibility guidelines for various UG courses of Bangalore University for Bengaluru North University for the year 2018-19.

2. NSS Programmes in Colleges:

The Registrar (Evaluation) and in-charge of NSS programme has brought to the notice of all the Principals the decision of recent meeting of the Registrars, Bengaluru North University and Bengaluru Central University's along with the Liaison Officer of the state NSS unit, Government of Karnataka and the Regional NSS Officer of Government of India regarding establishment of the Regional NSS Officer of Government of India regarding establishment of the NSS units compulsorily in all the affiliated colleges of BNU and BCU and to also appoint the NSS programme officers. Further, he informed that, letter from Bengaluru North University has already been sent to the principals of the colleges to submit necessary details. He has also informed the decisions taken in the meeting in respect of appointment of coordinators, submission of applications with necessary details as per the norms and regulations.

Further, with regard to the queries raised by the principals in respect of II and III Semester students continuing in the NSS units, the Registrar (Evaluation) explained that, these issues were already discussed in the meeting and the government will form necessary rules and regulations and same will be circulated.

The Principals of the Government Colleges have requested the Vice Chancellor to follow in cultural to follow in cultural fee structure similar to sports fee ratio to help colleges to organise the cultural programmes. The Vice Chancellor assured that, a committee will be formed to look into the matter to bring some solutions on these issues.

Starting dual degree /Diploma programmes as per the directions and guidelines of University Grants Commission:

While discussing the issues relating to the curriculum development, The Vice Chancellor informed that, UGC is issuing circulars to start dual degree/Diploma programmes have to be started in the colleges affiliating to the University. Also informed that, UGC in encouraging colleges for starting of Add-on programmes for which funding would be given by the UGC. The Chairman informed that, the current day curriculum is not completely orienting to the Job requirement and he highlighted the importance of the Add-on programmes in the form of PG Diploma/Diploma/ Certificate Courses and suggested to start form current academic year onwards.

Further, he informed that, BNU will provide all the guidance to the colleges to start Diploma/ PG Diploma and Certificate courses for the benefit of students to get the jobs.

4. Revision of UG/PG Curriculum:

While discussing on this subject, the Vice Chancellor informed the principals that, the current year we have to follow the existing syllabus of Bangalore University. From next academic year i.e., 2019-20 syllabus will have to revised and updating has to be done once in three years. He also suggested to include the practical components in the Arts/Commerce and other streams also.

5. Any other subjects:

The following issues were discussed and resolved as follows:

- Affiliation: From the next academic year, the BNU would try to follow the scoring pattern for affiliation purpose close to the scoring pattern of NAAC, so that, colleges would get the idea of fulfilling the requirements of NAAC format.
- Research Centre: The Notification will be notified as per the guidelines of Bangalore University to recognise the colleges as Centre for Research.
- Affiliation Orders in dual language: As per the request made by the Principals, it was resolved to issue the affiliation orders both in Kannada and English languages.
